24	Whereas, this Court has certified a litigation class defined as "All single-family				
25	residential customers of the Otay Water District who received water service after July 14,

27	Whereas, the parties, Plaintiff Coziahr on behalf of a certified class and Defendant Otay				
28	Water District, have met and conferred regarding class notice and notice administration.				

Whereas, the parties have reached agreement on such matters and now stipulate as follows:

STIPULATION

- 1. Pursuant to Rule 3.766 of the California Rules of Court, the parties agree that notice is necessary, so that class members may be apprised of their legal rights and the class action status of this proceeding. *See* Rule 3.766(b)(1).
- 2. The parties also agree that class members may exclude themselves from the action and retain their legal rights (if any). See Rule 3.766(b)(2).
- 3. Within sixty (60) calendar days of the mailing of the Class Notice, Class Members who wish to exclude themselves from (opt out of) the Class must do so in writing in accordance with the Notice. The written objection must be served in accordance with the directions in the Class Notice.
- 4. Any Class Member who does not exclude himself or herself from the Class may enter an appearance in the Class Action, at his or her own expense, individually or through counsel of his or her own choice. Any Class Member who does not enter an appearance or opt out of the Class will be represented by Class Counsel.
- 5. Given that the trial is currently scheduled for April 10, 2020, the parties agree that it is in the parties' and the Class Members' interests to reschedule the trial date to provide sufficient time for the Class Members to opt out. The parties stipulate to reschedule the trial from April 10, 2020 to June 12, 2020, or a date thereafter convenient to the Court that is before July 14, 2020.
- 6. The parties agree that notice shall be provided by a combination of mail, email, and/or publication. The manner of notice proposed is appropriate given (1) the interests of the class; (2) the type of relief requested; (3) the stake of the individual class members; (4) the cost of notifying class members; (5) the resources of the parties; (6) the possible prejudice to class members who do not receive notice; and (7) the res judicata effect on class members. *See* Rule 3.766(e).

[PROPOSED] ORDER

Upon review of the parties' stipulation regarding class notice and the appointment of a notice administrator, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Notice to the class is necessary.
- 2. Class members may exclude themselves from the action.
- 3. Within sixty (60) calendar days of the mailing of the Class Notice, Class Members who wish to exclude themselves from (opt out of) the Class must do so in writing in accordance with the Notice. The written objection must be served in accordance with the directions in the Class Notice.
- 4. The trial, currently scheduled to begin April 10, 2020, shall be rescheduled for June 12, 2020, or _____ [a date thereafter convenient to the Court that is before July 14, 2020]. Trial Readiness Conference continued to 5-29-2020 at 10:15 a.m.
 - 5. Notice shall be given to class members no later than 60 days before the start of trial.
 - 6. Notice shall be given in substantially the same manner as that proposed by the parties.
- 7. The content of the notice shall be substantially similar to the proposed notice attached as Exhibit 1.
- 8. Class counsel shall preliminarily bear the cost of notice at this time. The Court shall address any right to recover costs at a later date upon application from Class Counsel.
- 9. The Court appoints RG2 as Notice Provider, based on its qualifications and experience.
- 10. Defendant Otay shall provide to the Notice Provider information that is reasonably necessary to effectuate the notice plan approved by the Court, including a class list and contact information, no later than 10 days after the entry of this Order, unless that period is extended by agreement of the parties.
